READ & FEED BOOK CLUB

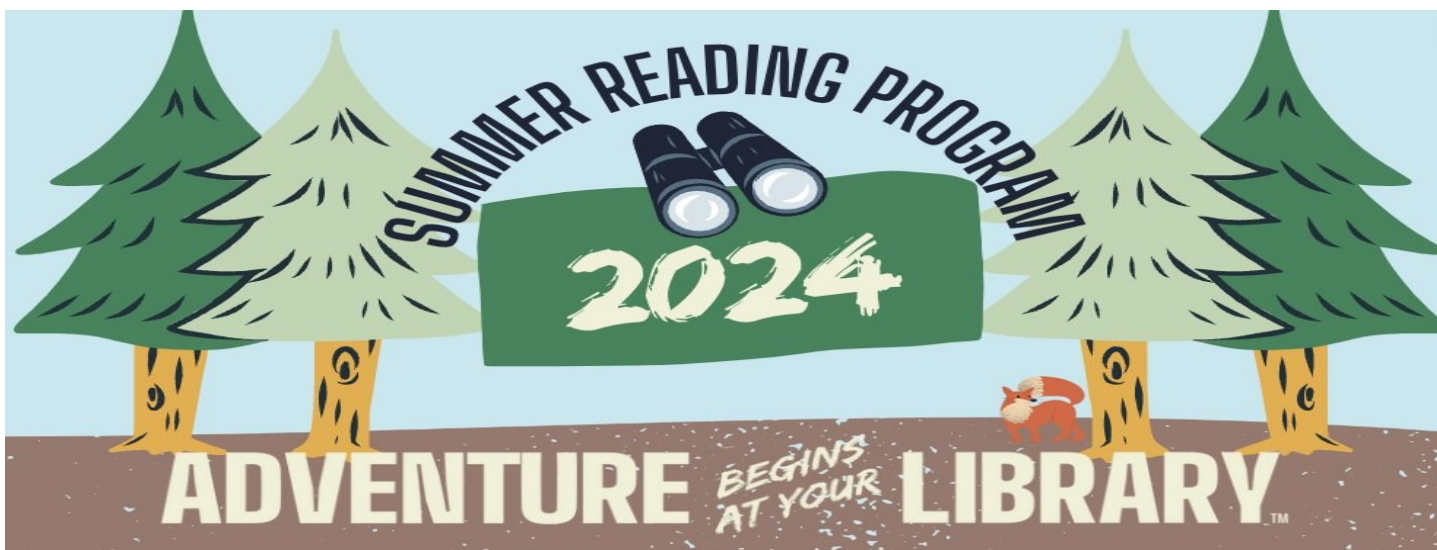
- Every month will have its own theme - read any book you want!
